

Important Safety Instructions

- 1. Ensure all plugs and sockets are properly connected and protected from water ingress.
- 2. Use only appropriate lighting hangers or clips to secure the strip lighting. Do not use staples, nails, or similar fasteners that may damage the insulation or permanently affix the product to a structure.
- 3. Do not cover the lighting. Covering may cause overheating, melting, or fire.
- 4. Do not operate the strip light while tightly coiled. Maintain a minimum of 15 mm spacing between cables to prevent overheating and avoid contact between cables and other components.
- 5. Do not puncture, cut, or shorten the strip lighting.
- 6. Do not use the product if the strip or cord insulation is damaged. Inspect regularly.
- 7. Do not submerge the strip light in water or use it near standing water or other liquids.
- 8. Do not install the product in cabinets, tanks, or enclosed spaces.
- 9. Avoid continuous flexing or bending of the strip lighting.
